## 22. SCRUTINY - SPECIAL RESTRICTIONS:

All vehicles must comply with Schedule A and Group 4H of the current CAMS Manual. CAMS approved helmet and apparel, compliant with Schedule D of the current CAMS Manual, and fire extinguisher to current NCR (Schedule H). Cars must be adequately muffled. Fuel must be in accordance with Schedule G of the current CAMS Manual. A current and valid CAMS Level 2NS/2NSJ Competition Licence and Club Membership Card of a NSW CAMS-Affiliated Car Club and log book (if issued) must be presented at document check.

Production 4WD ATV vehicles must be fitted with a driver's side window net.

## 24. PRIZES & TROPHIES:

Will be determined by fastest times recorded by handheld stopwatches. Penalties shall be determined in accordance with the Khanacross Regulations

Khanacross Competition: 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Outright

1<sup>st</sup> in each Class, 1<sup>st</sup> Junior and 1<sup>st</sup> Ladies

- 25. The CAMS permit will be displayed at the start of the event.
- 26. The organisers may refuse any entry without assigning a reason in accordance with NCR 83 of the current CAMS Manual.
- 27. Entries will be accepted in order of receipt.
- 28. Entries from competitors under 18 years of age must be counter signed / consented to by parent/guardian.
- 29. Personal Accident Insurance is provided by the purchase of a CAMS Level 2NS/2NSJ Licence or superior (2NS/2NSJ is the minimum requirement) as specified in Appendix I of the current CAMS Manual.
- 30. Public Risk Insurance has been effected by the organisers.
- 31. The organisers may cancel, alter, abandon or postpone the event without assigning a reason in accordance with NCR 59 of the current CAMS Manual.
- 32. Protests, if any, must be lodged in accordance with Part XII of the current CAMS Manual.

33. During any event, consumption of alcoholic beverages in the paddock, pits or any other portion of the competition venue under the control of the officials is expressly forbidden until all practice or competition activity is concluded for each day. Any driver or crew member who is found to be affected by alcohol on the day of the event or practice therefore shall not be permitted to participate. Refer NCR 145A of the Current CAMS Manual. In addition, the persons concerned will be subject to the Articles of the Standard Operating Procedure for Alcohol Testing and CAMS Anti-Doping Policy. Competitors, crews or officials may be randomly tested for alcohol by a CAMS Accredited Testing Official (CATO) or other drugs at any time during the event(s).

The CAMS Anti-Doping Policy, as appears in the CAMS Manual of Motor Sport and as amended from time to time, is recognized as an integral component of the NCR and is duly authorized as such. In any areas where the National Competition Rules and the Anti-Doping Policy conflict, the Anti-Doping Policy will apply.

34. Competition numbers shall be allocated at the discretion of the Clerk of Course.
