A current and valid CAMS Level 2NS/2NSJ Competition Licence and Club Membership Card of a NSW CAMS-Affiliated Car Club and log book (if issued) must be presented at document check.

Production 4WD ATV vehicles must be fitted with a driver's side window net.

- 24. The CAMS permit will be displayed at the start of the event.
- 26. The organisers may refuse any entry without assigning a reason in accordance with NCR 83 of the current CAMS Manual.
- 26. Entries will be accepted in order of receipt.
- 27. Entries from competitors under 18 years of age must be counter signed / consented to parent/guardian.
- 28. Personal Accident Insurance is provided by the purchase of a CAMS Level 2NS/2NSJ Licence or superior (2NS/2NSJ is the minimum requirement) Certain public, property, professional indemnity and personal accident insurance is provided by CAMS in relation to the event. - 29. Public Risk Insurance has been effected by the organisers.
- 30. The organisers may cancel, alter, abandon or postpone the event without assigning a reason in accordance with NCR 59 of the current CAMS Manual.
- 31. Protests, if any, must be lodged in accordance with Part XII of the current CAMS Manual.

32. Alcohol, drugs and other substances

Any holder of a CAMS 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of drugs (or other banned substances) and subject to a penalty(ies) for a breach in accordance with the CAMS Anti-Doping Policy and/or the CAMS Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy as published on the CAMS website. Consumption of alcohol in the paddock, pits or any section of the competition venue/course under the control of the Officials is forbidden until all competition is concluded each day. Accordingly, any holder of a CAMS 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may also be tested for the presence of alcohol by a CAMS Accredited Testing Official (CATO) in accordance with the CAMS Standard Operating Procedure for Breath Alcohol Testing.

- 33. Fuel and water is not available at the venue, Shell Eastern Creek is 5 minutes' drive north of the venue. Hot barbecue food and cold and hot drinks will be available for sale at the NSSCC club barbecue at the venue.
- 34. This event will include a Motor Sport Passenger Ride Activity (MSPRA) which shall be run under and in accordance with the CAMS MSPRA Policy.
