# The Rally of the Bay

July 11<sup>th</sup> brings the 2015 version of the Rally of the Bay to some of the best and well loved roads in the Batemans Bay area.

The event is a round of the NSW Rally Championship (8 stages of competition) and the ACT Regional Series (6 stages) – of course you don't have to be registered in those to come along and have a run – but you will have to comply with the apparel regulations for the relevant part – so if you want to do all 8 stages you will need the suit, gloves etc, and Frontal Head Restraints for both crew members!

We have decided to make use of the Rallysafe system compulsory this year for the entire field so you will also need to have pre-purchased and installed an 'Install Kit' direct from the Rallysafe store on their website – we won't be selling them at the event and you have to have one to start. We know this is yet another upfront cost, but firmly believe that the safety benefits of the tracking and alerts system will lead to more and more events requiring its' use, so your one-off cost now will get more use over the coming years ... You might also want to consider purchasing one of their 'damage waiver' policies to cover the cost of repairs / replacement of the unit if something unfortunate happens ... The hire of the actual unit is included in your entry fee and they will be available when you get to the event (pick yours up at documentation) and don't forget to return it!!

This year we have added an extra option for those who aren't interested in scoring points in the NSW Rally Championship or the ACT Regional Series ... but would like to have a run using pacenotes. The first six stages of the event make up a round of the NSW Pacenote Series (please note that you will need the same apparel as the NSW Rally Championship field to compete – even if you are only doing the first six stages). Pacenote runners can do all 8 stages if they like (as long as they pay us the correct entry fee!)

Rally HQ and the after event celebrations will be at the Bay Waters Resort while the Service Park will once again be at Mackay Park. There will be a ceremonial start adjacent to the Service Park (not along the waterfront this year) and we have planned for 3 spectator points – two during the day and one after dark – Spectator instructions will be available at the event.

On Saturday evening Bay Waters will be putting on a buffet meal for as long as required (nobody misses out); the bar will be open while it is still collecting money; results will be displayed and available thanks to the Phil Morley & Co scoring team — and everyone will have plenty of time to catch up with friends and share some tall, and occasionally true, tales from the day.

If you are looking for accommodation the Bay Waters should, of course, be your first port of call (no need to drive 'home' on Saturday night) but there are plenty of other options around the area. While it is winter the event is on the last Saturday of the NSW School Holidays so there could be a few more people than normal in town ... book early, or consider staying somewhere like the Steampacket Hotel or the Big 4 Holiday Park at Nelligen.

We look forward to you joining us for the rally event of the year in Batemans Bay!

#### Article 1 ORGANISATION

#### 1.1 Nature of Event

This event will be run as a meeting with three main competitions

- Bay Pacers (Round 2 NSW Pacenote Series)
- Bay Stages (Round 3 NSW State Championship)
- Bay Ramble (Round 3, 2015 Techworkz Automotive ACT Regional Rally Series)

The Event shall be conducted over Public, Private and Forest Roads within the Eurobodalla Shire and Shoalhaven Shire on Saturday 11<sup>th</sup> July 2015.

The Event is a competitive Event, designed to test the skill of the driver and co-driver, and the reliability and mechanical condition of the competing vehicle.

NOTE: The fields for the Bay Pacers, Bay Stages and the Bay Ramble will be seeded and run separately with a suitable "safety" gap between the fields. Different apparel requirements will apply to the various fields as per the 2015 CAMS Manual and these regulations.

#### 1.2 Authority

The event shall be conducted under the general provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA, the National Competition Rules (NCRs) of CAMS Ltd, the National Rally Code (NRC), the NSW Directors and Checkers Manual, the NSW Rally Competition Conditions 2015 and NSW Rally Series Organisers Conditions 2015, these Supplementary Regulations and any further regulations which may be issued by the organisers and approved by CAMS Ltd, using A to A timing as per National Rally Code 1.33. This event will be conducted under and in accordance with CAMS OH&S and Risk Management Policies, which can be found on the CAMS website at www.cams.com.au.

Certain public, property, professional indemnity and personal accident insurance is provided by CAMS in relation to the event. Further details can be found in the CAMS Insurance Handbook, available at <a href="https://www.cams.com.au">www.cams.com.au</a>.

In accordance with Section 6.9 of the Rally Code and NCR 59, the Organisers reserve the right to abandon, alter or terminate the event at any point.



#### **Article 2 Competition Details**

#### 2.1 Common Information

#### 2.1.1 Rallysafe

The use of Rallysafe transponders is compulsory for all vehicles entering this event.

All vehicles MUST be fitted with a Rallysafe install kit prior to the event – these WILL NOT be available for purchase at the event.

Install Kits are to be ordered directly from Rallysafe via their website - rallysafe.com.au

All competitors should be familiar with the Briefing Video which is also available in the Competitor section of the Rallysafe website.

The cost of hiring the Rallysafe unit is \$99 (GST inc.) per vehicle which is included in the Entry Fees listed for each section of the event.

Competitors should also consider purchasing a "damage waiver" for the unit from Rallysafe via their website – the cost of replacing a unit if it should be damaged beyond repair is \$1,800 plus GST which will be invoiced to the user of the unit at the time of its loss.

#### 3.3 Starting Order

The starting order will be determined by seeding using the NSW Seeding list and whatever other information the Organisers select. The seeded list of entries will be available as per the Event Programme.



The event will be run as 3 separate seeded fields with an appropriate gap between the fields:

- 1. Bay Pacers
- 2. Bay Stages
- 3. Bay Ramble

#### 3.4 Change of Entry

Competitors may, at any time up to the close of Documentation Verification, change the vehicle or crew members upon written notification to the Clerk of Course. A change of Driver or vehicle may necessitate the competitor to be reseeded.

#### 3.5 Crew Eligibility

Crews will comprise two persons only. The same crew will be required to compete throughout the Rally.

#### 3.6 Competitors Briefing

A Competitors Briefing will be held at 0945hrs Saturday July 11, 2015, at the Ceremonial Start location (Adjacent to the Service Park at Mackay Park). It is required that at least one member of the crew attend, and be present for the entire duration of, this briefing.

#### Article 4 DOCUMENTATION AND SCRUTINY

#### 4.1 Documentation

At Documentation Verification competitors will be required to present:

As per NCR 67 (xxiv) in the 2015 CAMS Manual:

- CAMS Competition Licence,
- CAMS affiliated Car Club Membership Driver / Co-Driver
- Vehicle Log Book (where required)

As per National Rally Code 2.1 (iii) of the 2015 CAMS Manual:

• Drivers Civil Licence and Co-Driver's Civil Licence (except where exempted under National Rally Code 2.1 (iii) of the 2015 CAMS Manual)

As per Schedule R, 1 of the 2015 CAMS Manual:

- Vehicle Registration Papers and proof of Third Party Insurance.
  - NSW UVP's will be considered as valid registration however competitors are encouraged to have their vehicle under NSW (or similar) Rally Registration
  - QLD registered vehicles will require a 3<sup>rd</sup> Party Extension

Road Book, Service Instructions, Competition Numbers and Advertising, etc will be issued at documentation verification.

Service crew personnel must be registered and signed in by the close of Documentation Verification.

#### 4.2 Scrutineering

Competitors are requested to have their vehicles and, where required, apparel scrutineered by an accredited CAMS Scrutineer in the week prior to the event and to present a fully completed and signed road event



scrutiny form at documentation. A copy of the form is included at the end of these regulations if required. A list of regional scrutineers is available at <a href="http://www.rallynsw.com.au/info/regulations/">http://www.rallynsw.com.au/info/regulations/</a> on the Scrutineering tab.

Any competitor who is unable to organise to be scrutineered as above must contact the Clerk of Course as early as possible to make other arrangements.

The Organisers reserve the right to examine vehicles at any time during the event and require compliance with the regulations before a vehicle can continue.

Post-event scrutineering, for eligibility, may be carried out at the finish of the event.

Four wheel drive vehicles that are not entered as Unrestricted vehicles and whose engine is supercharged/turbocharged, must be fitted with a restrictor as per the CAMS Manual of Motor Sport and must be fitted with a CAMS approved seal.

Particular attention will be paid to a vehicle's presentation. Vehicles with body damage or unpainted panels will not be allowed to compete. Vehicles must be presented to the scrutineer clean and ready to start with all compulsory equipment, including auxiliary lights, included.

#### 4.3 Timetable for Documentation and Scrutineering

As per the Event Programme.

#### **Article 5 VEHICLES**

#### 5.1 Exhaust Noise

All vehicles are required to conform to Schedule R, 7. of the General Requirements for Cars and Drivers and may be tested in accordance with the method in the Rally Code.

Competitors are reminded of Rally Code regulation 4.6 (iv) relating to broken exhausts.

#### 5.2 Safety

Safety requirements for the crew and the vehicle will be as per the 2015 CAMS Manual of Motor Sport. Particular attention should be paid to Schedules A & R of the General Requirements for Cars and Drivers.

#### Article 6 EVENT DETAILS

#### 6.1 Rally Headquarters

Rally Headquarters will be located at the Bay Waters Resort, cnr Kings Hwy and Princes Hwy, Batemans Bay.

#### 6.2 Event Format

There will be a promotional start in an area adjacent to the Service Park  $-1^{st}$  car departing at 1015hrs on Saturday morning. Vehicles will proceed from here to TC0 which will be located at the Service Park  $-1^{st}$  car due to leave TC0 at 1030hrs.

#### 6.3 Media Day

A media day will be conducted on Friday, July 10 on a section of road which will be closed to the public. This will take place between 1200hrs and 1400hrs and will only be available to a maximum of 12 invited vehicles and their crews.



This will take the format of some runs over the 'stage' by regular crews to obtain photographs and footage for media usage – as well as providing some 'rides' for media and invited guests.

Vehicles participating in this event must have been scrutineered prior to participation and the operation of this activity will be as per NRC 8.3.

#### 6.4 Service Park In Control and Final Time Control

Competitors may book into the following controls early (and only these controls) without penalty:-

- the 2 service park In controls (TC3A and TC6A); and
- the final control of the event, TC8A.

#### 6.5 Servicing

All servicing will take place at the Service Park, Mackay Park, Batemans Bay. Please refer to the Location Map within these regulations. For reasons of competitor and service crew safety, no Servicing or refuelling is permitted outside designated Service or Refuel Areas as identified in the Road Book.

Service Times will be as per the itinerary.

Service Park will be open as per the Event Programme and Service instructions will be issued at Documentation Verification.

No service vehicle may drive on a competitive stage during the running of the Event without the express permission of the Clerk of Course. If vehicle recovery is required, service crews are asked to contact rally headquarters for instruction.

There is pump fuel available near the Service Park.

The maximum distance between service points and pump fuel will be 113kms total with 57km competitive.

An OPTIONAL refuel is available in both of the first two sections (which are repeated stages) after 26km Competitive (64km Total) – this will be remote from the Service Park and is a Refuel ONLY – no outside servicing assistance will be permitted and officials will be monitoring crews behaviour. Route instructions to the refuel area will be included in the Service Instructions available at documentation – it is located 10.2km from the Service Park ... 1<sup>st</sup> car should be expected at approximately 11:50 on the first section and 15:20 on the second.

Service crew members must be registered with the Organisers by the close of Documentation Verification. A form is provided with these regulations and copies will be available at Documentation Verification. Only registered service crew personnel will be covered by CAMS Personal Accident Insurance for the event. The maximum number of service personnel that can be registered per competing vehicle is eight.

#### Article 7 GENERAL INFORMATION.

#### 7.1 Maps

All maps will be supplied by the Organisers.

#### 7.2 Odometer Check

The Odometer Check START 0 sign is on the Princes Highway headed North from Batemans Bay at the 100km/h speed sign just past the Kings Highway intersection. The start is indicated on the Location Map and directions for a 5km & 10km check will be included in the Road Book.

#### 7.3 Route Instructions

The event is fully route charted.



Tulip diagrams will be provided, but the written instructions are to take precedence should any conflict in interpretation be encountered.

No closed gates will be encountered in special stages of the event.

#### 7.4 Event Signage

It is a condition of entry that all competing cars display the event signage as provided by the organisers.

#### 7.5 Sunrise & Sunset

On Saturday, July 11 in Batemans Bay:

Sunrise 0708hrs
Sunset 1701hrs

#### 7.6 Penalties

Competitors are reminded of the penalties for exceeding speed limits, Clause 5.2 (iii) (p) 1 and 2, in the Rally Code.

#### 7.7 Results

The Clerk of Course reserves the right to take into account any available information when compiling the results, including control cards, etc., and to correct any verified recording errors.

The results are official and final, at 0700hrs July 15, 2015, should no protests on the results be received.

#### 7.8 Finishing Qualifications

All competitors must complete 100% of the route under the power of the competing vehicle to be classified as finishers and feature in outright results. Bay Ramble & Bay Pacers will finish at TC6A, Bay Stages at TC8A.

Any crew that fails to report to any control or enters or leaves a control in other than the prescribed direction shall be deemed to have retired from the event, the route being that as set out in the Road Book for each crew.

#### 7.9 Abbreviations

Abbreviations shall be as per the Rally Code.

#### Article 8 SAFETY OF COMPETITORS

#### 8.1 Non-Injury Stoppage on a Special Stage or Closed Road Section

In the event of a stoppage by a competitor which requires no medical assistance the competitor must:

- Immediately place triangles to warn following competitors.
- Place the OK sign (on the rear of the Route Instructions) on the vehicle in such a position that it remains clearly visible to all following competitors.
- If not causing an obstruction press the OK selection on the Rallysafe unit, if partially blocking the road etc leave unit in Hazard mode to warn arriving vehicles.
- All competitors stay as close to their vehicle as is safe to do so.
- If able to get the vehicle going, and wish to move it, do not leave the stage via another route proceed for the full length of the stage, in the correct direction.

#### 8.2 Accident involving Injury

Any competitor involved in an accident requiring assistance for a trapped or injured crew member should:



- Press the manual SOS selection on the Rallysafe unit even if it has started an automatic SOS the manual confirmation will help HQ.
- Immediately place triangles to warn following competitors (unless incapable of doing so).
- Display the SOS (on the rear of the Route Instructions) in a prominent position, visible to the next two
  competitors.
- After the first two following competitors, display the OK sign (on the rear of the Route Instructions) to the rest of the field.

Any competitor coming on another competitor involved in an accident must:

- Stop, if the SOS is displayed or if there is no visible sign displayed, and render assistance.
- If appropriate press the manual SOS selection on their Rallysafe unit as confirmation to HQ of the severity of the incident.
- If possible, contact Rally Command by mobile phone or radio, noting car number, cumulative distance to the accident site, and if known, general details of injuries sustained.
- If unable to contact Rally Command, write down the accident details, stop the next competitor and have them proceed immediately to the next SOS point or Special Stage Stop Point with the accident details.
- At the first practical time, fill in an incident report fully detailing the incident, and pass it to the Clerk of Course, or Control Official.

Failure to comply with these regulations will result in a report to the Stewards. A penalty can be applied at the discretion of the Stewards up to and including exclusion.

#### Article 9 REMINDERS.

#### 9.1 Lighting of Fires

The lighting of fires at any time during the event is strictly forbidden.

#### 9.2 Speed and Noise

Officials, who may be CAMS Observers and who will be Judges of Fact, may be appointed to measure the speed and noise of competing vehicles. All competitors and service crews are advised that a CAMS approved Noise Meter and/or Radar may be in use on liaison sections and/or service access roads of the event, to measure the noise and/or speed of competing vehicles and/or service vehicles. Penalties for competitors will be as per the CAMS Manual of Motor Sport.

#### 9.3 Behaviour of service crews

Competitors will be responsible for ensuring that Service vehicles and crews comply with Clause 7.6 of the 2015 National Rally Code.

Breaches of NRC 7.6(viii) will be referred to the Stewards who may impose a penalty.

#### 9.4 Retirements

Any crew retiring from the event must submit their road cards to the Stage End Control or the Sweep Car.

Accurate details of the reason for withdrawal and any damage to vehicles or other property must be supplied. An incident report must be completed if a competitor or other person sustains any injuries and the organisers may require any crew to complete an accident report or other CAMS forms.

Failure to comply with these conditions may result in competitors being referred to the stewards and charges being laid under NCR 183(viii) in reference to these regulations and the requirements of Appendix I of the 2015 Manual of Motor Sport.



#### 9.5 Rejoining

Rejoining in accordance with Article 6.10 of the NRC will be permitted in this event at the discretion of the Clerk of Course.

If the sweep vehicle catches up to a competitor who would normally be considered 'out of late time' the competitor may elect to either:

- withdraw, in which case they cannot participate further in the event, and must hand in their time card and withdrawal form; or
- request to rejoin at a future point, in which case they must hand their current time card to the sweep vehicle and then proceed to the event service park control and make application to rejoin.

Any competitor, who rejoins the rally in accordance with the above regulations, will have stage results recorded in the results, but will not be classified as a finisher or eligible for any awards.

#### Article 10 WHS ADVICE FOR ENTRANTS AND SERVICE CREWS

All personnel are asked to assess the risks associated with any practice that they are involved with, and take action to minimise the potential injury to themselves and any other personnel.

Please observe the following rules to assist our event to be a safe one.

- No smoking within the service park
- Use a liquid proof ground sheet beneath the car during all servicing and re-fuelling operations.
- Jack stands must be used when working under vehicle
- Suitable fire extinguisher required to be readily available when refuelling

#### Article 11 ALCOHOL, DRUGS AND OTHER SUBSTANCES

Any holder of a CAMS 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of drugs (or other banned substances) and subject to a penalty(ies) for a breach in accordance with the CAMS Anti-Doping Policy and/or the CAMS Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy as published on the CAMS website. Consumption of alcohol in the paddock, pits or any section of the competition venue/course under the control of the Officials is forbidden until all competition is concluded each day. Accordingly, any holder of a CAMS 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may also be tested for the presence of alcohol by a CAMS Accredited Testing Official (CATO) in accordance with the CAMS Standard Operating Procedure for Breath Alcohol Testing



# Appendix A – Location Map




#### Appendix B – Vehicle Numbering and signage requirements

#### Vehicle signage stickers

Important – the vehicle numbers supplied are made to go on and off cars without damaging paintwork. As such they are deliberately made with removable adhesive. When applying your vehicle numbers please **ensure that your car is clean and dry**. Press the stickers down **firmly**, and rub to the edges and the corners. Avoid lifting and re-applying.

The vehicle signage in use is a modified FIA style. Please refer to the sample vehicle diagram below:

- Larger Vehicle Numbers top front corner of the door.
- Door Plates (name of the rally) top of door behind the car number.
- Smaller numbers Top front corner of the windscreen, and also on the matching place on the rear windscreen.
- Scrutineering sticker this will be signed at Document verification upon receipt of a completed scrutineers report. Place it on the front Windscreen underneath the number.
- State/Multiclub section labels front windscreen under vehicle number.
- Gary's Motorsport Tyres stickers, Rally NSW stickers and Rally NSW sponsor bar stickers supplied by the Rally panel must be displayed by all registered competitors, in a clearly visible position on the sides of the vehicle.
