



COVID-19 Event Update – 1 – 26 June 2020

Motorsport Australia strongly encourages the download and activation of the Australian Government's 'COVIDSafe App' for all event participants.

Under NO circumstances should anyone with symptoms consistent with COVID-19 attend the event. This includes any fever, respiratory symptoms, shortness of breath, sore throat, cough, fatigue, or sudden loss of sense of smell.

Under no circumstances should anyone attend the event if they have been;

- i. overseas in the previous 14 days; or
- ii. in contact with someone who has been overseas in the previous 14 days; or
- iii. in contact with a known COVID-19 positive case in the previous 14 days.

It is highly recommended that if any attendee exhibits symptoms consistent with COVID-19 prior to the event they should consider taking a COVID-19 test. Contact details for testing clinics in NSW can be found at this link:

If interstate, please seek out the equivalent clinics in your State.

You may also wish to consult with your medical practitioner on measures you could consider prior to the event.

In light of the recent increase in community contracted cases of COVID-19 **ALL** people who are directly associated with the event are asked to seriously assess their current health status with respect to COVID-19 like symptoms or their risk of having had exposure to COVID-19 prior to attending.

In addition to the existing arrangements for competitors, we will be implementing a check on body temperature using a contactless thermometer for all Rally HQ and Service Park attendees, the main gathering points for the event. Stage Team Officials with meet points out on the course will be exempt from this requirement unless they visit either of these locations. These checks will occur at Rally HQ on Friday and Saturday and also at the Service Park on Saturday. **Individuals will be approached and checks will be carried out progressively** with an effort to test everyone and once tested you must have a "pass" placed against your name before any further involvement in the event. We will come to you. We ask for your co-operation if approached for a test to allow us to assist in keeping everyone healthy. It is a NSW Government and Motorsport Australia requirement that ALL attendees provide their name and contact details if future contact tracing is required so if we do not already have those details you may be asked for them.

[Any entry that is required to withdraw up to their nominated start time due to COVID-19 related symptoms or a failed temperature check will receive a full refund of their entry fee. – ***For competitors and crew only***]
